#### I. BACKGROUND

Special Assistance to the Certain Disabled (SCD) is a program that provides a limited monetary payment each month to a beneficiary who meets the program's eligibility requirements. SCD beneficiaries are not eligible to receive Medicaid; however they must be disabled as determined by the definition of disability adopted for this group. A disability determination is made by Disability Determination Section based on a medical review.

### II. CONTENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF CHANGE

- A. The Medical Review reference number has been changed and added to policy. The form is the <u>DSS-1653, Report of Medical Examination</u> and must be completed for every application.
- B. References to the income section of the SA policy have been changed to the <u>Economic Benefits Integrated Eligibility Policy Manual (IEM.)</u>
- C. With the development of NCFAST, reference to EIS has been removed.
