I. BACKGROUND

Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP) policy was updated to indicate the program will use 150% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL). It was later discovered this could not be done without legislative approval. This change updates references to the correct 130% FPL requirements. Other clarifications were added as outlined below.

II. SPECIFIC CHANGES

Section 300.02 and 400.03 Application Requirements:

 Clarification added that the DMA-5001 is <u>ONLY</u> needed if the applicant is not an active FNS, WF, or Medicaid recipient **and** the OVS or IEVS will be ran prior to the applicant signing the DSS-8178, Energy Programs Application or the signature page from the application in NC FAST. The DMA-5001 is not required in any other situation.

Section 300.09 Income & Deductions:

- Clarification added to explain that representative income from FNS, MA, or WF may be used to verify income if current.
- Clarification added to explain OVS is required to be ran on all LIEAP applications.
- Income chart updated with correct 130% of the FPL amounts.

Section 300.12 Benefit Determination and Method of Payment:

Income range by Family Size chart updated to reflect correct 130% of the FPL amounts.

Section 400.03 F Eligibility Determination:

• Clarification added to explain OVS is required to be ran on all CIP applications.

- Clarification added to indicate CIP has no base period. Use actual gross income and anticipated income received in the month of application.
- Income chart corrected to reflect the correct 150% of FPL amounts.

Section 400.03 G Crisis Determination:

• Policy was rewritten to help clarify what constitutes a crisis for CIP.
