The purpose of this change notice is to make changes regarding Trafficking FNS benefits.

II. SPECIFIC CHANGES

Changes have been made to the following sections:

A. Section 800, Claims

Section 800.05 has been updated to state that Trafficking referrals also may result from the attempt to buy or sell FNS benefits online and in public.

B. Section 805, Requirements for Establishing Recipient Claims

Section 805.05, C.6 has been updated to add clarification regarding Intentional Program Violation with regards to Trafficking FNS benefits.

C. Section 830, EBT Recipient and Retailer Fraud

Trafficking definition has been updated in Section 830.01 to include 'or the attempt to buy or sell FNS benefits online and in public'.

Email address to send reports has been updated in Section 830.03, C.
