The Division of Aging and Adult Services has updated several Special Assistance Eligibility (SA) Manual Sections and the SA application workbook, [DAAS-8190](#).

**II. CONTENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF CHANGE**

- A. Revised the DAAS-8190.** The DAAS 8190 has been updated to align with policy. The form incorporates the 8190-S and 8190-NS into one document.
- B. SA-3100**
1. Combined Sections **SA-3230-Age** and **SA-3250-Residence** into this section;
  2. Updated **General Eligibility III A** to match [10A NCAC 71P.0804](#).
  3. Removed EIS references;
  4. Removed the statement that hospice residential facilities must have an agreement with DAAS. This requirement was eliminated by adoption of [10A NCAC 71P.0102](#);
  5. Revised the diagnosis that must be included on an FL-2 for a Special Care Unit and clarified the visit requirement;
- C.** The **Preface Section** has been removed;
- D.** Section **SA-3120 EIS Instructions for SA** has been removed.
