

## PERINATAL SUBSTANCE USE PROJECT


### Treatment Referrals

Screening, information, and appropriate referrals for women throughout North Carolina who are pregnant or parenting and using substances.

Updated listing of available perinatal and maternal substance use disorder treatment beds (residential services) throughout the state.

### Admission Preference

In accordance with 45 CFR §96.131 Treatment Services for Pregnant Women of the Substance Abuse Prevention & Treatment Block Grant (SAPTBG), pregnant women are given preference in admission to these programs/facilities. Priority admission is as follows: (1) Pregnant women using substances intravenously, (2) Pregnant women with a substance use disorder, (3) Women using substances intravenously, (4) All other




### Technical Support
