Screening for Medicaid Eligibility under the **COLA Pass-along**

Use the screening guide below to determine if an individual qualifies for COLA Pass-along status (under the Pickle Amendment). If the individual is unable to answer the questions or is unsure of any answers, check other resources to determine Pass-along status. Document the applicant/beneficiary (a/b) Pass-along Eligibility or Ineligibility on the Person Page in NC FAST. Refer to MA-2110, Pass-along.

*This screening guide is to be used to identify individuals eligible for COLA Pass-along only. For widow(er)s and adult disabled children, also evaluate under other Pass-along groups. Refer to MA-2110, Pass-along and DHB-5150A Pass-along Screening Guide.

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Step One:	Ask the applicant the following questions and check other sources to determine if the a/b qualifies for Pass-along.
Question 1:	Are you now receiving a Social Security check?
	If no, STOP. The individual is not eligible.
	If yes , continue to question 2.
Question 2:	After April 1977, has there ever been a month in which you were eligible for, and received, both a Social Security check and a SSI or SA check (or did you get SSI only and then were found retroactively eligible for Social Security for that month)?
	If no, STOP. The individual is not eligible for COLA Pass-along. Evaluate under other Pass-along groups.
	If yes , continue to question 3.
Question 3:	What is the last month in which you were eligible for and received both Social Security and SSI or Social Security and SA?
Step Two:	Look up the month and year in which the person last received both Social Security and SSI. Refer to the Pickle Chart in MA-2110 Pass-along. Find the percentage that applies to the year SSI or SA stopped. Multiply the current amount of the person's (and/or spouse's) Social Security benefits by the applicable percentage. Use this amount after multiplying as the countable SSA income.
	Current Social Security benefit amount Percentage from table for applicable month Countable Social Security income Other Countable income Total Countable income =
Step Three:	Compare the total countable income to the current SSI or SA income limit. If less than the current SSI or SA income limit, the person is COLA Pass-along eligible, from the standpoint of income, for Medicaid benefits. (The person must still satisfy separate Medicaid resource and non-financial requirements.)
