Subject: Child Support Evidence

The purpose of this Dear County Director Letter is to clarify current guidance that is stated in Chapter 7 page 29 of the SCCA Policy Manual. Current guidance reads that child support evidence must be entered under the child's name. However, this is not current NC FAST functionality.

New guidance issued in the NC FAST weekly communication now requires that child support income should be entered under the parent's name. However, when the child is living with a non-parent caretaker (e.g., a grandmother), and the caretaker's income is not counted toward the child, the Unearned Income evidence should be entered in the child's name, and it will count as income in the income unit.

Guidance for Applying Child Support Income:

- If the child lives with a parent: Enter child support evidence under the parent's name.
- If the child lives with a non-parent caretaker: Enter child support evidence under the child's name, ensuring the system counts the child support income as unearned income for the child. Child Care Workers must ensure the "Non-Parent Caretaker" box is checked for the non-parent caretaker when entering Household Relationships.
