Subject: November 2024 Roster Submission

The purpose of this Dear County Director Letter is to communicate attendance reporting for the month of November 2024. To assist providers affected by Hurricane Helene, DCDEE plans to make accommodations for the November 2024 roster submission process.

The following guidance only applies to the **November 2024** service month and only for the **affected counties**: Alexander, Alleghany, Ashe, Avery, Buncombe, Burke, Caldwell, Catawba, Cherokee, Clay, Cleveland, Gaston, Graham, Haywood, Henderson, Jackson, Lincoln, Macon, Madison, McDowell, Mitchell, Polk, Rutherford, Swain, Transylvania, Watauga, Wilkes, and Yancey.

- If a facility has not yet reopened due to Hurricane Helene or was closed for part of the month and open for the remainder, the days the facility was closed may be marked as "Present."
- If a facility had some children who were able to attend and some children who have not yet been able to return, the provider may mark the children who have been unable to attend as "Present".
- NC FAST will NOT automatically submit rosters for any provider. Providers are responsible for recording and submitting attendance rosters for November 2024 by December 5th at 9:00pm.
- November 2024 will be the final month for roster accommodations.
