Subject: Recertification Extension

The Division of Child Development and Early Education (DCDEE) recognizes the hardship that families continue to face following Hurricane Helene. In response, the Division is extending the certification periods by 12 months for families in the affected counties.

This extension applies to certification periods ending in January, February, and March 2025. For example, a case due for recertification in January 2025 will automatically be extended through January 2026 in the NC FAST system. If a child is in Graduated Phase Out that expires in January, February or March 2025, the Graduated Phase Out will NOT be extended and the child's eligibility will end when the Graduated Phase Out was originally set to expire.

The affected counties include Alexander, Alleghany, Ashe, Avery, Buncombe, Burke, Caldwell, Catawba, Cherokee, Clay, Cleveland, Gaston, Graham, Haywood, Henderson, Jackson, Lincoln, Macon, Madison, McDowell, Mitchell, Polk, Rutherford, Swain, Transylvania, Watauga, Wilkes, and Yancey.
